There was a time when wood bowl making was a cherished trade, passed down through generations of families. Today, with the abundance of inexpensive materials available to mass produce tableware, our handcrafted bowls have become a specialty item. This traditional craft is almost a lost art.

Holland Bowl Mill prides itself in the beautiful quality of our wood products, made entirely in America by our artisans.



A MISSION OF SUSTAINABILITY

Our commitment to the environment is reflected in all decisions made in the production of our products. Only the larger diameter trees are harvested, leaving smaller, less mature trees to grow in their place. By removing the vast canopies of leaves, it allows sunlight to penetrate the forest floor where young foliage and wildlife can prosper. This process is called select cutting. The logs are delivered to our mill in 8-, 10- and 12-foot lengths and no logs under 16" in diameter are accepted. This is where the bowl making process begins.



A LOOK AT OUR PROCESS

Our artisans cut each log into large blocks and then into bowl blanks. The more significant blanks produce a total of 4 bowls, each measuring 17, 15, 12, and 9 inches in diameter. Smaller bowl blanks measure 10, 8, 7 and 6 inches, and each grouping nests inside one another.

After the bowls have had a chance to dry, they are finely sanded to a smooth finish, then dipped in a food-grade mineral oil or rubbed with our own Bee's Oil wood preserver. This enhances the natural wood tones, richly displaying the characteristics of each unique bowl. During this process, no excess wood is wasted; rather it is recycled as firewood and the shavings are used for animal bedding.

Holland Bowl Mill offers a lifetime guarantee for all our bowls, and take pride that we are manufacturing tomorrow's antiques that will last for generations.

THE AMERICAN WALNUT COLLECTION

The American Walnut collection features an extraordinary rich color variety, grain patterns and figuring. Heartwood typically ranges from a pale brown to a dark chocolate with stunning streaks of sapwood.

THE RED OAK COLLECTION

The Red Oak Collection features heartwood with a light to medium brown honey tones, commonly with a reddish accent. Quartersawn sections display prominent ray fleck patterns and straight grains, but can encase wavy grain and interesting bird's eyes.

THE TORCHED OAK COLLECTION

The Torched Oak Collection features heartwood tones with reddish accents. To obtain a rustic look we keep the outside rough and lightly scorch the bowls with a fire torch. The end result is stunningly burnt grain stripes.

THE MICHIGAN CHERRY COLLECTION

Michigan Cherry is characteristically straight-grained with a fine satiny smooth texture. The heartwood varies from rich red to reddish-brown and will darken with age and exposure to light. In contrast, the sapwood is creamy white.

Never let water stand in a wood bowl for long periods of time and never clean wood bowls or any wood product in the dishwasher. Holland Bowl Mill recommends using water and a small amount of mild soap, then hand dry.
